

Adopted Minutes Special Council Meeting June 9, 2020

Mayor Wosje called a Special Meeting of the Plymouth City Council to order at 5:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 3400 Plymouth Boulevard, on June 9, 2020.

Access to Drive-In/Drive Through Businesses

Planning Manager Thomson presented the report on the current language and possible language change in the Zoning Ordinance for drive-in/drive through businesses. She noted that on November 12, 2019, Council adopted an interim ordinance temporarily prohibiting drive-in/drive through restaurants in order to allow staff to complete a study of this matter.

It was the consensus of the Council to not change the language.
