

Adopted Minutes Special Council Meeting June 23, 2020

Mayor Wosje called a Special Meeting of the Plymouth City Council to order at 5:43 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 3400 Plymouth Boulevard, on June 23, 2020.
